

MALDEN PARK OBSERVATION AREA

Through the project's Community Benefits Plan Neighbourhood Infrastructure Strategy, an observation area in Malden Park is being constructed to provide an attractive, safe location for residents, students and tourists to observe construction of the Gordie Howe International Bridge.

Construction of the observation area started in September 2023 and will take approximately seven weeks.

Construction activities include:

- excavation of the observation area
- foundational work and granular fill (mixed gravel)
- landscaping including mulch and planting trees and shrubs
- installation of furnishings like benches, railings and binoculars.

Malden Park remains open during construction, however, some impacts to amenities are anticipated. These may include:

- potential trail closures
- limited closures of specific areas of Malden Park
- limited parking
- noise and vibration.

When complete, the observation area will be a landscaped area at the highest elevation in Malden Park enhanced with railings, benches and wayfinding signage, directing viewers' attention to a clear vantage of the Gordie Howe International Bridge.
