Apply Now: Local Community Group

Community benefits play an important role on the Gordie Howe International Bridge project. A robust plan is bringing \$20 million in neighbourhood betterments plus more than 80 workforce development initiatives to ensure the Windsor-Detroit region has opportunities to engage with the project.

The project is seeking volunteers to serve on its Local Community Group, a 16-member collective that represents the communities of Detroit/Delray, Windsor/Sandwich, Windsor-Essex County and the Greater Detroit Area, providing valuable input and linkages that help the project team better understand community and stakeholder perspectives in the delivery of the Community Benefits Plan.

Local Community Group members will also assist with the review of annual community funding applications as part of the Community Organization Investment initiative within the Community Benefits Plan and participate on subcommittees focused on topics such as community, art, or history.

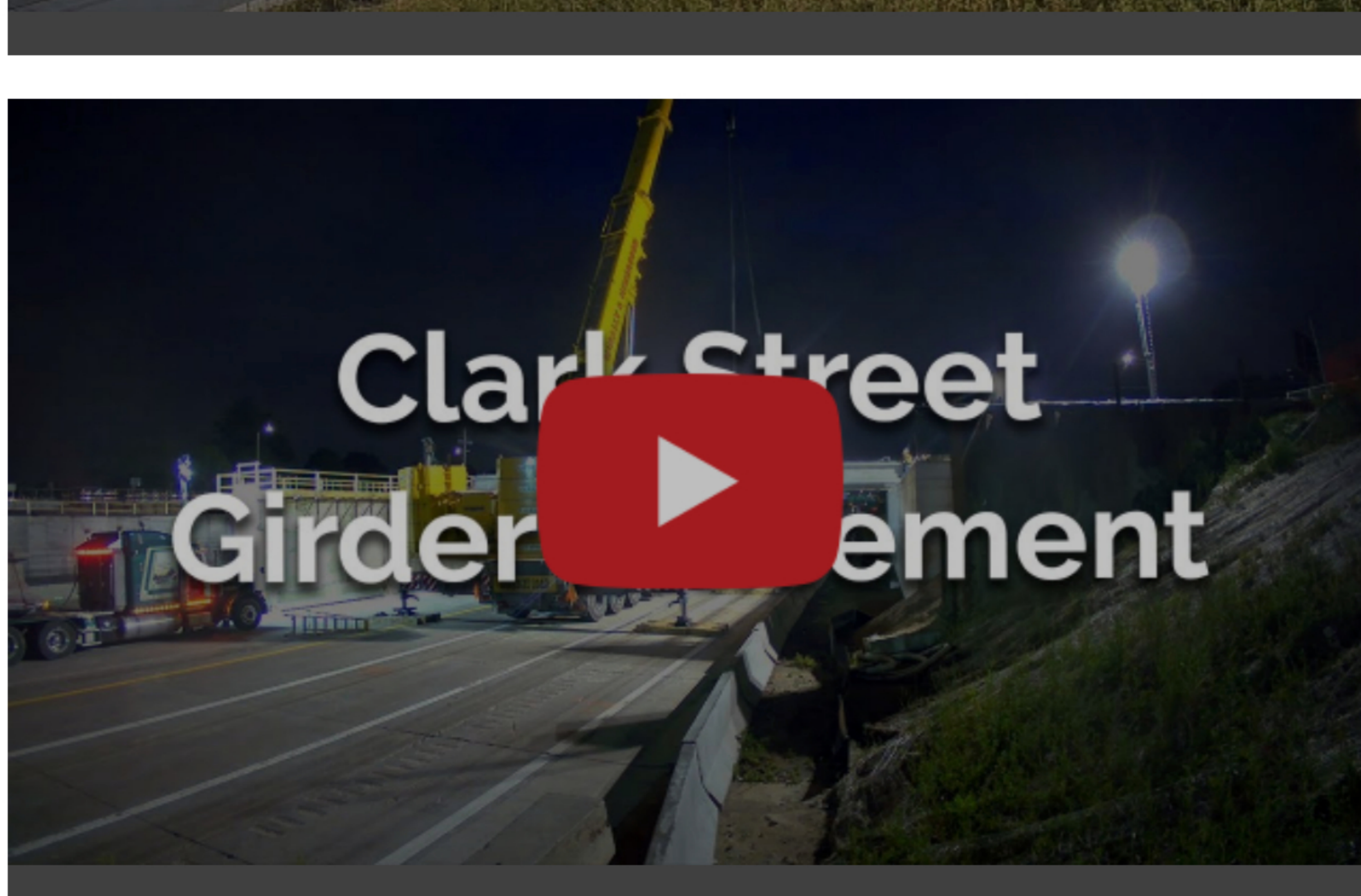

New US Flyover Footage

Traffic Disruptions in Southwest Detroit

I-75 Northbound

- Three left lanes will close overnight on northbound I-75 between Clark Street and Springwells Street, starting June 21 - July 23, 2021, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. daily as needed.

Campbell Street

- Southbound Campbell Street will close between West Jefferson Avenue and Lauderdale Street for sewer rehabilitation, starting July 6 - August 9, 2021.

Detour Route for Southbound Campbell Street

Local traffic on eastbound and westbound Fort Street heading toward Campbell Street southbound will be detoured to take Junction Street southbound west on West Jefferson Avenue then to Campbell Street.

West End Street

- West End Street will remain closed between Fort Street and Melville Street until August 10, 2021. Local traffic and business traffic will have access to West End street between Norfolk Southern Railroad to Melville Street.

West End Street and Fort Street Detours

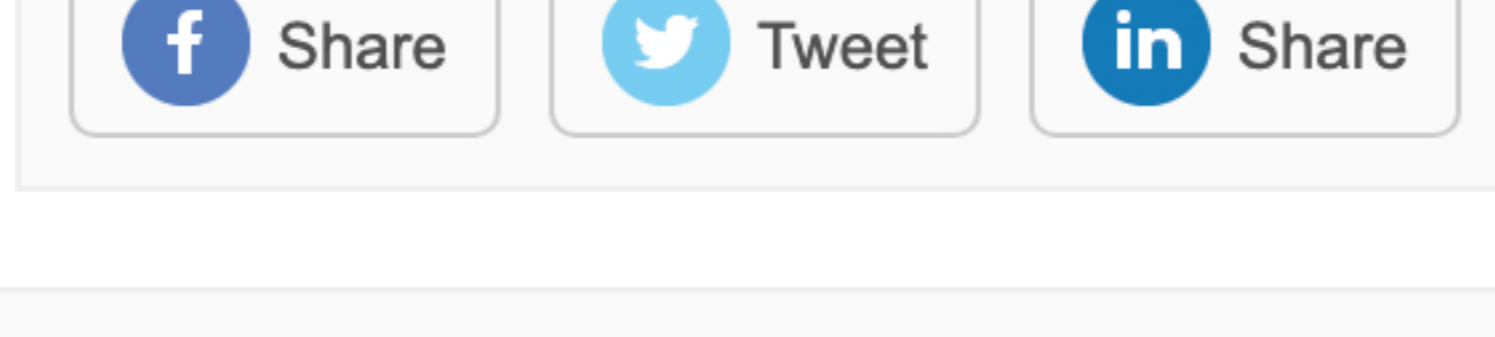
- Local motorists traveling northbound on West End Street will be detoured east on Melville Street, north on Green Street and west on Fort Street.
- Motorists on West Jefferson Avenue will be detoured north on Green Street and West on Fort Street.
- Motorists on Fort Street will be detoured south on Green Street and west on West Jefferson Avenue. This detour will be utilized by Historic Fort Wayne Traffic to access West Jefferson Avenue.
- Detroit Truck Ferry traffic will be detoured west on Fort Street, south on Dearborn Street and east on West Jefferson Avenue.
