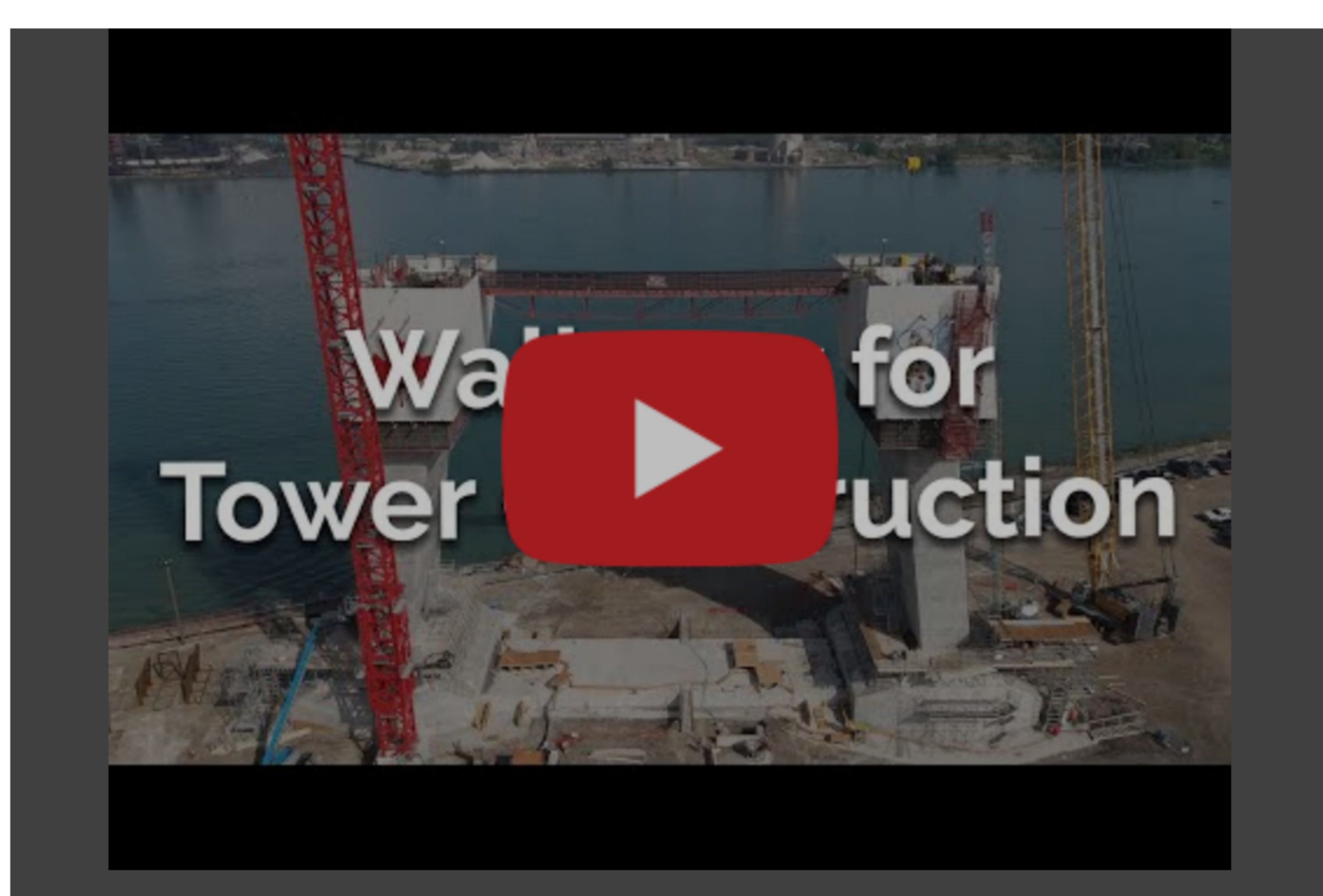
Canada Day Office Closure

Traffic Disruptions in Southwest Detroit

As construction of the Michigan Interchange continues, Bridging North America will extend the temporary closures at Lewerenz Street for public lighting boring work.

June 22 – July 2, 2021

- Northbound Lewerenz Street will close between southbound I-75 Service Drive and Lafayette Boulevard daily as needed.

June 22 – July 16, 2021

- Lewerenz Street will close between Fort Street and northbound I-75 Service Drive.

July 6 – 16, 2021

- Northbound Lewerenz Street will close between southbound I-75 Service Drive and Lafayette Boulevard daily as needed.

Lewerenz Street Detour Route:

Traffic on southbound I-75 Service Drive heading toward Lewerenz Street northbound, will be detoured to take Beard Street northbound, west on W. Lafayette Boulevard, then to Lewerenz Street.

I-75 Northbound - NEW

- Three left lanes will close overnight on northbound I-75 between Clark Street and Springwells Street, starting June 21 - July 23, 2021, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. daily as needed.
- All lanes will remain open during the Independence Day holiday weekend, starting July 1 - 5, 2021.
