Upcoming Traffic Disruptions in Southwest Detroit

As construction of the Michigan Interchange continues, Bridging North America will implement a number of road closures that we wanted to make you aware of.

Junction Street:

Junction Street will remain closed at the southbound I-75 Service Drive until March 19, 2021, to support watermain relocation work. Access to schools, residences and businesses will be maintained.

Detour Routes:

Southbound Junction Street traffic at the Vernor Highway intersection heading to southbound I-75 Service Drive will be detoured to Vernor southbound, turn left on Livernois Avenue heading southbound, turn right on to southbound I-75 Service Drive, then turn left on Waterman southbound, turn left to Fort Street eastbound, then to Junction Street.

Northbound Junction traffic at the I-75 Service Drive intersection will be detoured to take Southbound I-75 Service Drive, turn right on Dagoon northbound, turn right on Vernor Highway eastbound, then to Junction Street.

I-75 Service Drive:

The following streets will remain closed to through traffic at southbound I-75 Service Drive until March 31, 2021, from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily as needed:

- o Morrell Street
- o Ferdinand Street
- o Lansing Street
- o McKinstry Street

The right lane of the southbound I-75 Service Drive will remain closed until March 31, 2021, from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily as needed, in the following locations:

- o Between Morrell Street and Ferdinand Street
- o Between Morrell Street and Lansing Street
- o Ferdinand Street and McKinstry Street
- o Lansing Street and Clark Street

During these closures, access to southbound I-75 Service Drive from Morrell, Ferdinand, Lansing and McKinstry Streets will not be possible. However, access to residences and businesses will be maintained. BNA will not close two streets at the same time during watermain relocation work.

The left lane and middle lane of the southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Ferdinand Street to Clark Street from March 16 - 31, 2021, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily as needed to support watermain relocation work..

The right lane and middle lane of the southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Ferdinand Street to Clark Street from March 16 - 31, 2021, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily as needed to support watermain relocation work..

One lane will remain open at all times for through-traffic on southbound I-75 Service Drive. When the right lane closes on the Service Drive, the entrance to the alley between Lansing Street and Ferdinand Street will close. Residents will be able to access the alley from Porter Street only. Access to schools, residences and businesses will be maintained.

The northbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Junction Street and northbound I-75/Clark Street off-ramp starting March 19 - 31, 2021.

Detour Routes:

Northbound I-75 Service Drive will be detoured to take Junction Street southbound, turn right on Fort Street eastbound, turn left on Clark Street northbound, then turn right to northbound I-75 Service Drive.

Southbound Junction Street traffic heading to northbound I-75 Service Drive will be detoured to continue on Junction Street southbound, turn right on Fort Street eastbound, turn left on Clark Street northbound, then turn right to northbound I-75 Service Drive.

Northbound and Southbound Service Drives:

On March 25, 2021, the I-75 Service Drive in both directions will close between Clark Street and Dagoon Street until June 15, 2022. Junction Street will remain open to through traffic. (see attached for detour route)

McKinstry Street:

McKinstry Street will close at the northbound I-75 Service Drive starting March 19 - 31, 2021, to support watermain relocation work

Clark Street:

The Clark Street ramps to north and southbound I-75 will be closed beginning March 25, 2021

Livernois Avenue:

The Livernois Avenue ramps to north and southbound I-75 will be closed beginning March 25, 2021
