COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INVESTMENT

The application period for the **Community Organization Investment (COI)** recently closed with approximately 30 applications received. This initiative is a five-year commitment to provide an annual investment of **\$100,000** to registered non-profit or charitable organizations located in or serving residents of Sandwich/west Windsor and Delray/Southwest Detroit. Funds are used to support events, programming and infrastructure improvements that benefit these communities.


The 2022 recipients will be announced in late spring. The application window for the 2023 round of funding is anticipated to open in November 2022.


WEST Award
