# The Project

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) and working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public-private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

Join us at a Public Information Meeting to meet project representatives and receive a project update on: Michigan Interchange Phase 1 construction, including upcoming closures, detours and demolition of bridges at Springwells Street, Livernois Avenue and Clark Street; a Vibration Monitoring Program for owners of properties identified within potential zones of influence surrounding major construction areas; United States Port of Entry (POE) barrier wall aesthetic design options; and the Community Benefits Program. The meeting is open-house format; presentations are scheduled for 3:30 p.m. and 5:45 p.m.
