September 30, 2021, marks the first National Day for Truth and Reconciliation in Canada. The day honours the lost children and survivors of residential schools, their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process. Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority offices will be closed while employees observe this holiday. Regular business hours will resume Friday, October 1, 2021.

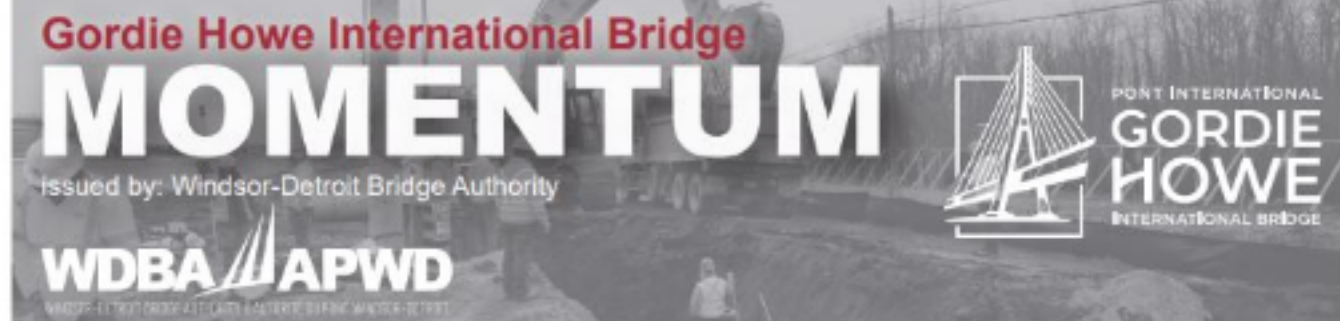

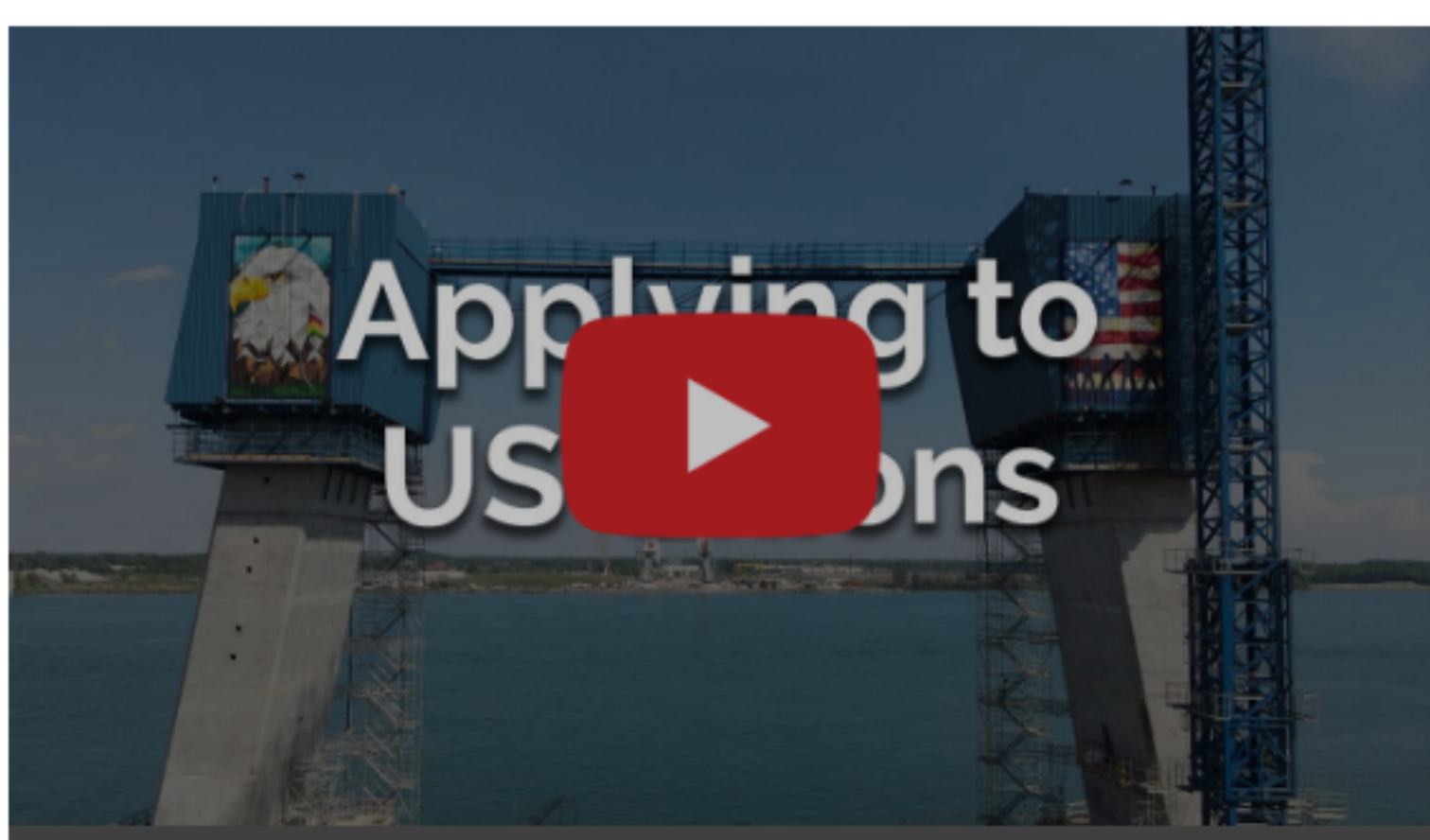

1000 DAYS OF CONSTRUCTION

On July 1, 2021, the Gordie Howe International Bridge team marked 1000 days since the start of construction. Progress over the first 1000 days includes: near completion of all design work; earthworks, utility work, the start of building construction and the completion of the Perimeter Access Road at the Canadian Port of Entry; earthworks and utility work at the US Port of Entry; demolition and the start of reconstruction of three road bridges as part of the Michigan Interchange; and completion of the tower foundations and the start of construction of the bridge towers.
