- are located in or provide services to the Sandwich/West Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit communities, and
- are a registered charity, registered non-profit or have a trustee relationship with a registered organization.

ABOUT THE COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INVESTMENT

The Neighbourhood Infrastructure Strategy of the Community Benefits Plan includes a commitment to provide a \$50,000 (CAD) annual investment allowance for community organizations located in or servicing Sandwich/West Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit. Funding will be made available on an annual basis from 2020-2024.

Eligible organizations can submit funding applications until January 31, 2020, for the 2020 funding cycle. Requests can range from \$1,000 and \$25,000 (CAD) for events, programming and infrastructure improvements that will benefit the neighbourhoods located closest to the project.
