

2020 COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INVESTMENT

APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN



As part of the Community Benefits Plan, the Gordie Howe International Bridge team is launching the 2020 Community Organization Investment to support eligible organizations located in or servicing Sandwich or Delray/Southwest Detroit residents.

Funding will be made available on an annual basis for a five-year duration from 2020 and 2024. There is an annual \$50,000 (CDN) investment allowance per country and requests for funding can range from **\$1,000 - \$25,000** (CDN).

Applications will be considered for funding if:

- The applicant is a registered charity, or has a trustee relationship with a registered charity
- The applicant is located in or provides services to the Sandwich, Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit communities
- The requested funding will be used to support events, programming and infrastructure improvements that will directly benefit the Sandwich or Delray/Southwest Detroit communities
- The requested funding aligns with one of the Community Investment Priorities, including: community partnerships, community safety and connections, economic benefits, and/or aesthetics and landscaping.

Applications for the 2020 funding cycle will be accepted until January 31, 2020.
