• Block wall installation, interior plumbing, electrical, mechanical and HVAC rough-ins continue for the

maintenance building.

• Reinforcing steel, second-floor and third-floor hangar installation and underground utility work continues for the

main building.

- Slab on grade preparations continue for the secondary inspection building.
- Structural steel work continues for the client processing building.
- Backfilling activities continue for the primary inspection lane canopy.
- Waterproofing and backfill activities continue for the tolling building.
- Reinforcing steel for the piers and concrete placements for the pier footings continue as work begins on the booth footing for the tolling plaza.
