Canadian Port of Entry (POE)

- · Interior plumbing, electrical, mechanical and HVAC rough-ins continue for the maintenance building.
- Reinforcing steel placements, second-floor and third-floor hangar installation and underground utility work continues for the main building.
- · Slab on grade preparations continue for the secondary inspection building.
- · Underground utility work and slab on grade preparations are progressing on the client processing building.
- Structural steel erection begins for the primary inspection lane canopy.
- · Waterproofing and backfill activities continue for the tolling building.
- Reinforcing steel and concrete placements for the pier and booth footings continue for the tolling plaza.
- · Surcharge work on the East gateway is ongoing.

Canadian Bridge site

- · Modifications continue to the tower jump form system.
- Concrete, rebar and formwork continue for the upper cross beam in the transition area from tower legs to pylon head.
- · Concrete, rebar and formwork continue for back span piers.
- Approach bridge pile driving continues this week.
- · Pier table floor beams continue to be erected.
- · CanAm steel for the bridge deck continues to arrive on site.



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
