HVAC rough-ins for the maintenance building.

- Underground service work continues for the client processing building.
- Reinforcing steel and formwork continue for the pier foundations and booths for the primary inspection lane canopy. Concrete placement continues for the footings and booth walls.
- Footing formwork and reinforcing steel installation continues for the tolling building.

- Concrete and rebar work continue to lift the north and south towers.
